TeamKakata Profile

In early 2020, a group of US-based Liberians from Kakata, Margibi County, saw the need to organize themselves into an association after attending two funerals of Kakata Family Members. The idea aimed at securing services and assistance for the people of Kakata in the areas of education, infrastructure, health, and social welfare. Instead of meeting only at funerals, they decided to help with the needs and improve the lives of their people in Liberia. With brilliance of key founding members, Teamkakata (TKA) was formed as a non-profit charitable organization, and granted a 501 (c) (3) status to operate in the US. Since its founding, it has provided hospital supplies to C.H. Rennie Hospital and educational materials, as well as food to the less fortunate families of Kakata.

Kakata has more than 33,945 residents, it is the second largest students' population in Liberia, with about 5,000 high school students and more than 10 high schools in the city, including the Booker T. Washington Institute (BWI), LIBERIA's oldest and equipped vocational institution established in 1929, and named in memory of an African American educator, and an intellectual of the 19th century.


